

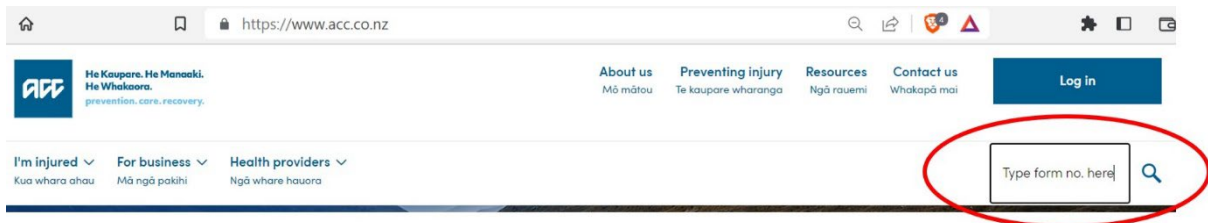
ACC provide treatment and support for Covid-19 vaccine injury if a physical injury is sustained which is considered unnecessary and not a normal consequence of the vaccine.

Accepted claims may allow for support such as treatment, compensation, rehabilitation, equipment, transportation, managing at home, or grants if a family member dies of an injury.

### **How to make an ACC Claim**

A number of different forms are required in the instructions below. To download a copy of the most up to date form you need, go to [www.acc.co.nz](http://www.acc.co.nz), click on the search icon and type the form number to locate it.



- Record **all** of your symptoms, even if you don't think they are relevant.
- Record a **before** and **after** account of your symptoms.

**Lodge an ACC45 Injury Claim form through your GP / hospital / approved health professional.**

**They should also lodge an ACC2152 form with the submission, for details of treatment injury.**

Do this as soon as possible.  
You have up to 12 months after the date of injury.

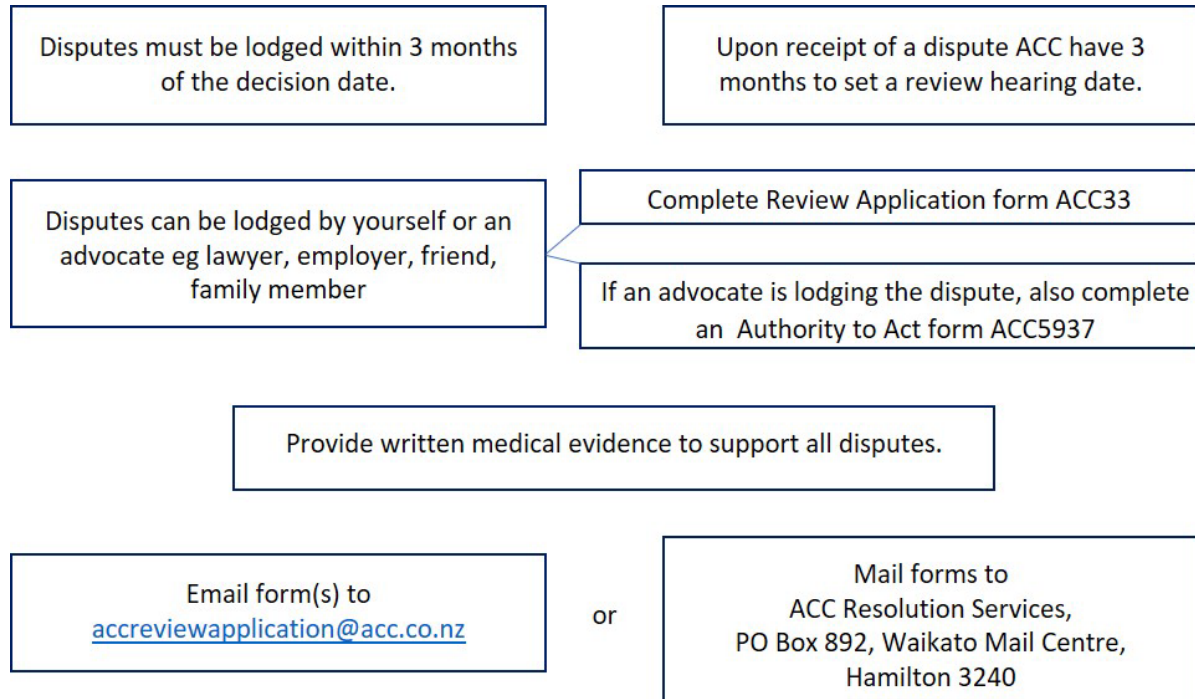
ACC may accept a claim lodged outside these limits  
Unless the delay affects their ability to make a decision.

*\*Health professionals are obliged to inform you about your right to also make a complaint to the Health and Disability Commissioner, where you have been harmed from treatment.*
